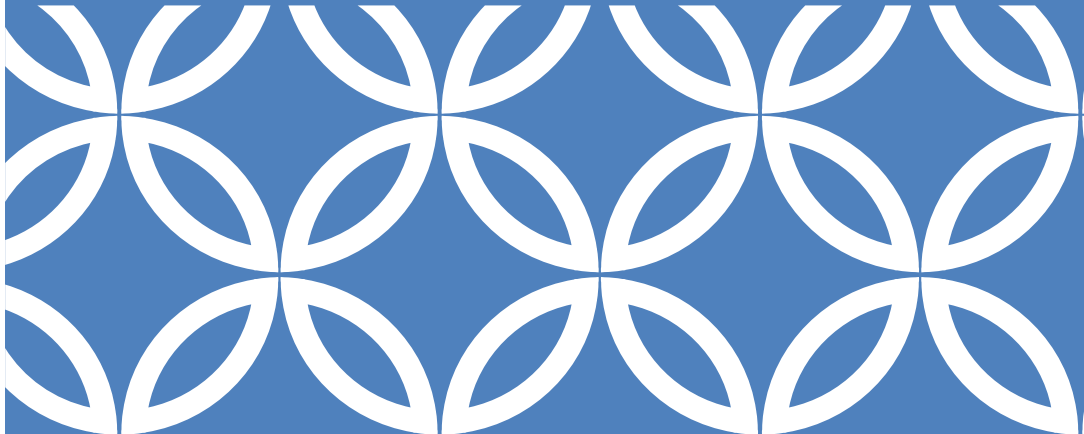

Our overall focus is to help our guests get back into permanent, sustainable housing and employment as quickly as possible.

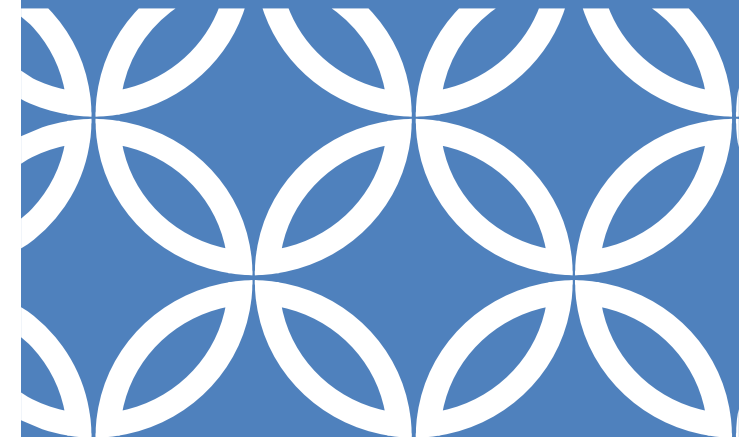




WHAT DO WE DO?

- Social Service Agencies

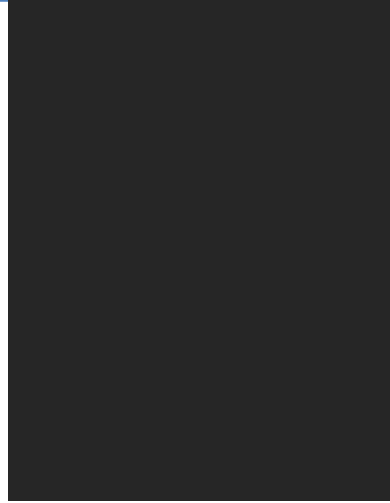


AT THE DAY CENTER

- Enjoy the fellowship of a diverse group of volunteers

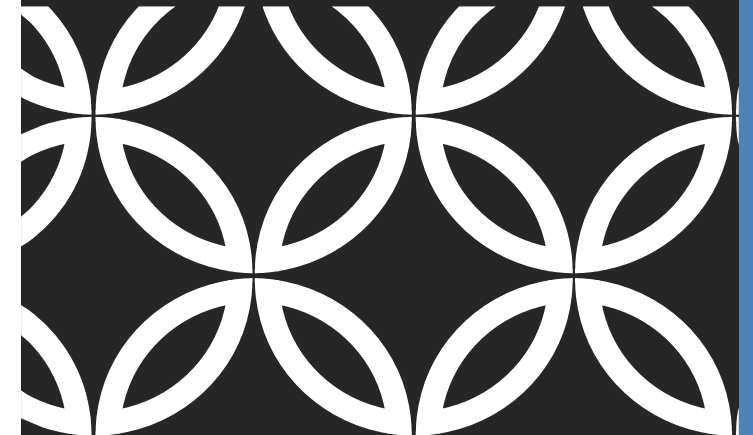




EMERGENCY NEEDS

BECOMING A GUEST

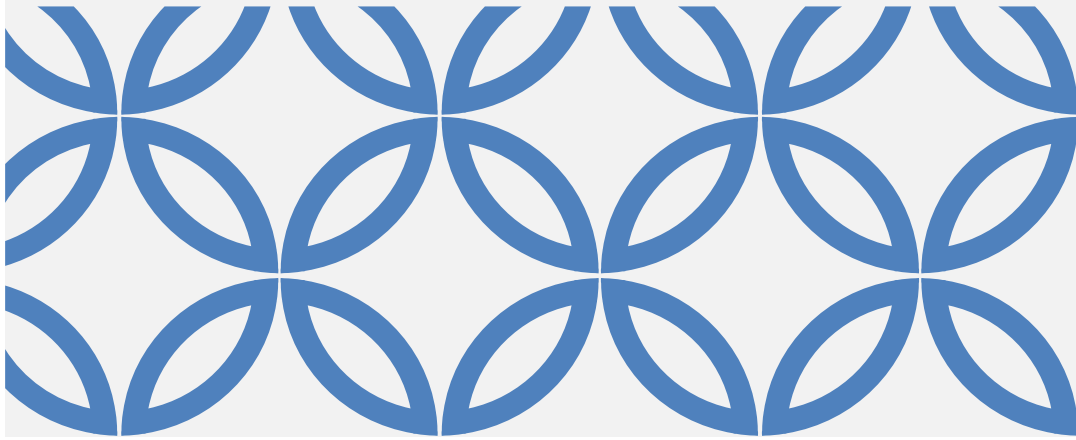

ALWAYS A NEED:

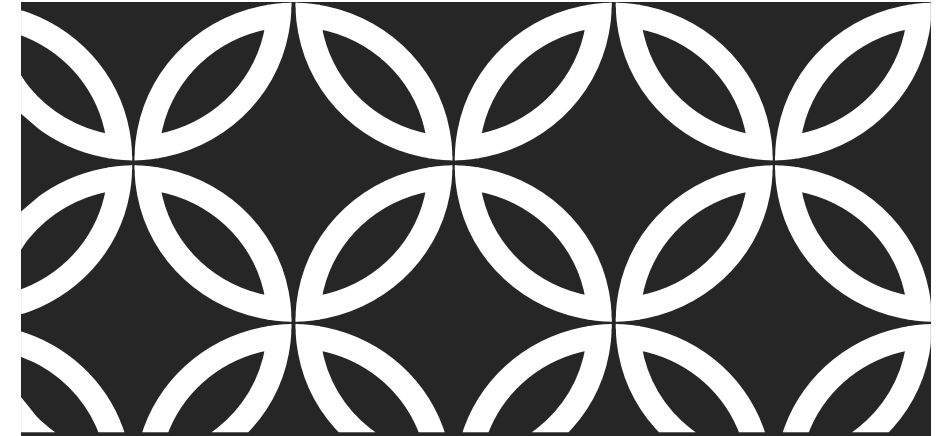
